Situation:

Duisburg-Meiderich is a district in the north of Duisburg, which is characterized by many migrants and poverty. The **EFG Duisburg-Meiderich, “Kirche-am-Bahnhof”**, is a Brethren congregation that is undergoing reorientation. “livingroom” is a part of this: We want to be “on the road together” with people in the district, help them in a practical way and also offer them an opportunity to join a congregation.

“livingroom” wants to provide a response to the plight of youth, a help to break out of the cycle of poverty, discover potential and specifically promote it. Our foundation is the Christian faith. The 50–60 participants between the ages of 6 and 20 mostly have a migration background.

“livingroom” is run by a team, mostly of volunteers and is supported by donations.
